



**Start** From the Green in front of St Martin's Church **A** cross road to Grove Hill. Follow roadway, past the Agricultural Machinery Sales and uphill until it veers **R**. Walk to small gate and fingerpost signed Great Hill and Hardy Monument ahead **B**.

Go through gate and cross field to small gate into woodland. Follow path through wood, which leads into a field. Keeping to field edge walk towards the barrows you can see on the ridge ahead of you.

Stay on this path, ignore private road going off to the **R**. Look behind you here to see Clandon bowl barrow. Continue straight ahead on track, ignore footpath on the **R** **C** and pass through a gateway. Follow track straight on until you reach a double gateway into a field **D**. Go through and take footpath to the **R**, across field and up hill. Head towards small gate on skyline to the **R** above you **E**.

Go through the gate and walk to the **R** of the barrow ahead. Join a grassy track to a gateway ahead. Go through this gateway. You can see Hardy's Monument on the ridge to the **R** here. Continue ahead, until you see the coastline.

**F** Join the South Dorset Ridgeway National Trail and turn **R** towards Hardy's Monument. Follow  to Bronkham Hill. Explore the barrows of this Bronze Age cemetery, beware of the shake holes.

Continue on path following . Passing the Jubilee Trail fingerpost on your **L** **G** walk on until you reach a small metal gate on **R** hand side **H**. Go into this field, with two barrows on **L** and follow fence line until you come to a large metal gate and road **I**.

Turn **R** and walk down hill, (Care!) until you reach the entrance to Ballarat Farm on the **L** hand side **J**.

Turn **L** onto farm track. Stay on this track passing by houses and later farm buildings and continue on downhill until you reach a tarmac lane **K**. Follow the lane to the **R** and then to its exit onto a road. Cross over and turn **L**. Follow road for a short distance (Care!) and turn **R** into North Rew Lane **L**.

Immediately look for a footpath on the **R** and cross over stile. Follow path through a small wood until you reach another stile. Cross over into a field

Walk along field edge until you reach a stile and gate on the **R** hand side. Cross the next two fields until you reach a stile. The uneven ground is the remains of the mediaeval village of Orchard or Rew. Cross stile to Church Farm.

At the farm house cross lane to stile straight ahead and walk along edge of a small field. Go over another stile and turn **R**. Walk downhill to fingerpost junction, continue ahead until tarmac lane the turn **L**. Pass the sheep washing pool on the **L** hand side and continue to road and pub ahead. Turn **L** to return to the church **A** and bus stops.
