Walks around the Fleet





Knights to Moonfleet

- Alight the bus at Knights In The Bottom bus stop. Walk across the front of the Victoria Inn, go through the gate at the side and across the field to the edge of Bagwell Farm Touring Park
- Turn right onto the track then enter the park through the gateway just above the playground. Follow the road downhill past the shop then turn left in front of the stone toilet building and immediately right. Follow the site road through the park down to the stile at the far end. The path continues straight across the edge of two fields and joins the South West Coast Path near the edge of the lagoon.
- Turn left and follow the South West Coast Path to the Moonfleet Hotel. Go past the hotel for 200m, through a wooded area, footbridge and stile.
- Turn left off the South West Coast Path across a field to the minor hotel road. Continue right up the hill to a cross road junction.
- At the crossroads turn left and follow the road past the entrance to West Fleet Farm Holiday Farm. When the road turns left, carry straight on along the gravel road/bridleway back to Bagwell Farm. Near the playground, take the path right across the field to return to the Victoria Inn and bus stop.





Chesil Beach — 15 miles long and born from landslides that eroded after the last ice age, 20,000 years ago — protects the special habitat of the Fleet Lagoon. The crashing, open sea is safely distant, a faint accompaniment to the calls of birds that find refuge in the tranquil waters.
